A message from Pastor Randy:

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Looking at the snow outside it is hard to believe, but spring ushers in in only one week, and Palm Sunday, Confirmation, Holy Week and Easter are right on its tail. And, as usual, there is a lot going on here at Trinity.

On Palm Sunday three great young people, Emma Nicol, Ben Nichol and Brayden Runnels, will be confirmed. The single 10:00 service will start with palms and will include their confirmation vows and a different litany. The service will be followed by a salad luncheon honoring the confirmands. It will be a wonderful time for young and old, and especially these three young adults and their families.

On Maundy Thursday, at 7:00, we will celebrate the Last Supper with a Passover Haggadah. Many scholars believe that this traditional Jewish celebration was the genesis of the Christian Eucharist. We will incorporate the Eucharist into our commemoration. The service will begin in the Social Hall and end in the Nave with a stripping of the altar and the traditional rendition of Psalm 22.

Good Friday will see us reliving the Stations of the Cross at 7:00. This somber service reminds us of the suffering and abandonment of Jesus during his final hours and of the sacrificial love that he offered us even to his death. It is a quiet, moving service.

And of course, on Easter Sunday we celebrate the resurrection. A community sunrise service is planned for Power Park. And we at Trinity will have a single 10:00 service followed by an Easter Egg Hunt on the lawn.

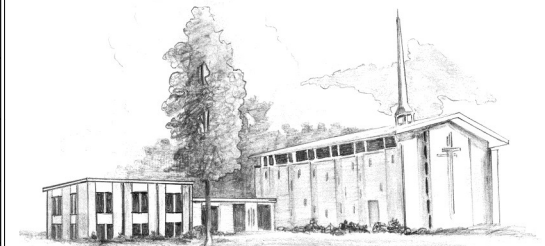
